Hi Terry,

I've been looking into what we could supply FDA for soybeans with incurred glyphosate. What level are you looking for, e.g., several hundred ppb, several ppm? Also, how much would you like to have and in what form? We could easily provide a few hundred grams of ground material but for whole beans we could supply perhaps up to a kilogram.

It isn't difficult to find soybeans containing glyphosate. In the preliminary method work we've performed we needed to dilute many of the samples when following procedures we have used for wheat.

I would be interested in learning more about your non-derivatization method if you are able to share any information.
