
**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY COMPLAINT FOR WRIT  
OF MANDAMUS SHOULD NOT BE GRANTED**

Before the court is a Complaint for Writ of Mandamus, filed July 11, 2017. Plaintiff seeks to compel Defendant to respond to a public record request. The Court has reviewed the Complaint and finds Plaintiff has demonstrated a preliminary basis for relief.

It is therefore **ORDERED**:

1. Defendant shall have twenty (20) days in which to show cause in writing why the relief Plaintiff requests should not be granted. Such response should include the factual and legal basis and address all issues contained in the Complaint.
2. Upon filing of the response, Plaintiff shall have ten (10) days in which to file a reply, should it so choose.
3. An expedited hearing is hereby ordered pursuant to § 119.11, Fla. Stat. The date, time, expected duration and location of the hearing will be set in a separate order.


