STIPULATION AND ORDER

On December 20, 2017, the Court ordered the parties to file either a further Joint Status Report or stipulation of dismissal. The parties have now resolved this case, including an agreement with regard to payment of attorneys' fees and costs. The parties agree and stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation and Order shall constitute dismissal with prejudice of Plaintiffs' sole claim for relief. The dismissal of this action shall be effective upon the Court's signing and entry of this Stipulation and Order on the docket as an order of the Court.
2. After dismissal of this action, Defendant shall pay to counsel for Plaintiff a lump sum of \$4,500 in attorneys' fees and costs in this matter. Plaintiffs agree that payment of this sum shall constitute full and final settlement of all claims by Plaintiffs for fees, costs, and expenses against Defendant in this action.
3. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Stipulation and Order.


