Dear Ms. Stevenson:

I am writing in regard to several documents you recently produced in response to Mr. Ruskin's Public records act requests.

(1) In Batch #4, you have redacted the names of email recipients in several places, while in other places you have left the names of email recipients visible but redacted their email addresses. In other places, you have left visible both the name and email address of a recipient. Attachment 1 to this letter contains several examples of this. What is the basis for redacting the names of email recipients? And what is the rationale being used to determine whether to redact a recipient's name, email address, or both?

(2) We previously requested that you inquire why two attachments referenced on page 10 of Dr. Van Eenennaam's Biotechnology Industry Organization production were not produced. Attachment 2 to this letter contains the relevant page. You stated in your October 17, 2016 letter that you "would raise this subject with [Dr. Van Eenennaam] upon her return and will advise of the decision." If you have discussed this issue with Dr. Van Eenennaam please provide a response to our question about why these attachments were withheld. If you have not yet spoken to Dr. Van Eenennaam, please provide an estimate of when you intend to do so and when we can expect to receive a response to our question.

(3) On page 18 of Dr. Van Eenennaam's Monsanto production, there is a reference to how Monsanto VP Robb Fraley invites Cornell Professor Sarah Evanega as a dinner guest to an event. However, on page 106 of this same batch all references to Professor Evanega in the same message are redacted. Attachment 3 to this letter contains the relevant emails. What is the basis for redacting references to Professor Evanega, when Mr. Ruskin has specifically requested all emails concerning contact between certain UC Davis faculty and Professor Evanega?

(4) On page 88 of Dr. Van Eenennaam's Monsanto production, Monsanto's Lee Quarles suggests changes to Dr. Van Eenennaam's presentation at the IQ2 debate. Attachment 4 contains this email. What is the basis for withholding the attachment to this email?

(5) On page 116 of Dr. Van Eenennaam's Monsanto production, the email from Monsanto's Gary Hartnell to Dr. Van Eenennaam regarding a paper on glyphosate in urine is mostly redacted. Attachment 5 to this email contains this email. What is the basis for redacting the comments by Mr. Hartnell?

(6) Page 1 of Daniel Sumner's Monsanto production includes an email from Brandon Castillo concerning a conference call with Bicker, Castillo & Fairbanks, Monsanto, and Professors Alston and Sumner about their No on Proposition 37 paper. The names of several recipients of the email are redacted. However, in an earlier production (Batch #2, page 2), the same email was provided to Mr. Ruskin and the names of the recipients were not redacted. Attachment 6 contains these emails. What is the basis for redacting the names of the email recipients on page 1 of the Sumner/Monsanto production?

(7) On page 3 of the Daniel Sumner/Winner & Mandabach production, the email indicates that the subject of the comments in the email is a typo in the attached document. The comments describing the type are redacted. Attachment 7 contains the email. What is the basis for redacting the comments about the typo?

(8) On pages 4-5 of Daniel Sumner's Winner & Mandabach production, a substantial amount of the text of the emails is redacted. Attachment 8 contains these emails. What is the basis for redacting the content of these emails?


(9) On page 40 of Julian Alston's Monsanto production, Monsanto's George Gough reviews the Alston/Sumner paper for No on 37 and makes comments. The email indicated that Mr. Gough's comments were sent in an attachment to the email that was not produced. Attachment 9 contains the email. What is the basis for withholding the attachment containing Mr. Gough's comments?

Finally, in your October 17, 2016 letter, you wrote that "searches for documents responsive to Mr. Ruskin's requests included all attachments and responsive emails." (Underline added.) I understand your statement to mean that email attachments containing responsive information are being reviewed for production to Mr. Ruskin and will be withheld only upon a determination by your office that they are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act.
