Hi Jeff- Just wanted to touch base with you in regards to a meeting we had this week with EPA. I can elaborate further on our biweekly conference call but thought it will be important to let you know that EFED identified field volatility as a gap that needs to be closed. We are assessing internally what we could use and/or whether we need new studies or not. In the meantime, I wonder if you guys have field trials to that extent, I believe it will have to be a comparison with DMA salt.

Although we submitted field data to support the buffer, the Agency is still confirming the validity of the PMRA model (they were asking us about the raw data supporting the model). They did not want to discuss the actual status of reviews so we could only check if they have everything they need from us.
