Dear Dick

Thank you for your letter of 23 September 1976. Is there any further information on the Los Angeles case?

*on PP 796 - E. m. m. m. Read 11/16/76*

I hope you have now received a copy of my report CTL/R/390. This has been extensively discussed both at CTL and PPD and I enclose a final copy for you. A further report on dog and monkey studies will follow shortly.

Dr Sanderson, Lewis Smith and I have now discussed the haematology of paraquat at length and a report is in preparation. We have agreed to set up a study to attempt to establish whether the bone marrow changes seen after acute exposure in rats are due to a red cell aplasia or an increase in white cell precursors. We should have some further information in this area by the beginning of 1977 and I would suggest that the next up-date of the review of CTL research progress should take place around then.

Have you been able to contact Ken Fisher re: oxygen and paraquat? We are proposing further work on this subject and it would be helpful to know more about his attitude.
