Christin:

I think there are several options for SPH:

- If there is sufficient interest within SPH, we may be able to set up a **completely separate SPH-focused visit** by Dr. Regli. This would be a "personalized visit" with whatever group of researchers, PI's and others you would want to assemble. This would be separate from the 4pm PI general session and the 12:00 noon lunch. It could be mid afternoon (2:30 or so) or maybe in the morning. **If this is of interest, let me know now and I will confirm that it can definitely be done.**
- There is the opportunity to have someone from SPH attend the **12:00 noon lunch**, which, as I said, is likely to be a broader and more strategic discussion of how leadership in larger units (schools, depts., etc) should view relations with DARPA.
- Finally, there definitely will be a **4pm general session** geared toward PI's who interested in learning more about DARPA. Whether you do an SPH-focused visit or not, you can **always** send interested PI's to that.
