EcoHealth Alliance would like to request travel approval for Dr. Alice Latinne to travel from New York, NY, USA to Wuhan, China from October 19-22, 2018, for meetings with in-country partners and to attend the 8th International Symposium on Emerging Viral Diseases. From China, she will travel to Bangkok, Thailand from October 23-26, 2018, for the Thailand Global Virome Project meeting. From Thailand, she will then travel to Jakarta and North Sulawesi, Indonesia from October 30 to November 8, 2018 for meetings with in-country partners. From Indonesia, she will travel to Chiayi, Taiwan from November 14-17, 2018 to attend the 3rd International Symposium on Biodiversity and Health in Asia.
*Travel 10/27-10/29, and 11/9-11/13 will be covered by Dr. Latinne on personal funds.

Trip purpose: China – In Wuhan, Dr. Latinne will meet with PREDICT-2 in-country partners and attend The 8th International Symposium on Emerging Viral Diseases from October 19-22, 2018. She will present an oral communication entitled, “Origin and cross-species transmission of bat coronaviruses in China.” Thailand – In Bangkok, she will attend the GVP meeting together with representatives from PREDICT and EcoHealth Alliance. Indonesia – In North Sulawesi, Dr. Latinne will meet with in-Country PREDICT partners and assist them in qualitative data collection. Taiwan – In Chiayi, she will attend The 3rd International Symposium on Biodiversity and Health in Asia from November 14-17, 2018 and present an oral communication entitled “Diversity and origin of bat coronaviruses in China”.

2.
