The Committee publishes opinions under the aegis of the WHO and FAO on risk assessments for additives and contaminants in food. I have participated in the Committee as both a Member (2 meetings, 2010-11, with voting power, responsible for decisions concerning published opinions) and as a Temporary Expert (14 meetings, 1998-2010, non-voting, responsible for preparing draft documents concerning risk assessments for substances in food). The documents prepared are non-binding opinions of the expert attendees.</p> <p>I have completed numerous dietary exposure assessments for food additives as well as contaminants, including mycotoxins, chloropropanols, methylmercury, perchlorate, and others. I helped develop the Single Portion Exposure Technique (SPET) system for the JECFA procedure for safety assessment of flavouring substances.</p> <p>I worked as a member of the WHO/FAO update project to renew Environmental Health Criteria (EHC) 70 (now EHC 240), participating in an international workshop in Annapolis MD, USA in May 2005.</p> <p>I am currently invited to participate in the 76th meeting of the JECFA in Geneva, June 5-14 2012.</p>

The tool will be offered under the aegis of ILSI at no cost to users.</p> <p>I have resigned these positions effective Apr. 27, 2012.
