The game has been over, but it might be still worthy to discuss a universal philosophy to many international conflicts.

(1) Rights & wrongs of US presidents

- (i) Bush was right, for starting the Afghanistan war;
- (ii) Bush was wrong, for starting the Iraq war;
- (iii) Obama was right, for killing Bin Laden in Pakistan;
- (iv) Obama was wrong, for not ending the Afghanistan war after the decease of Laden;
- (v) Trump was right, for the wish to end the Afghanistan war;
- (vi) Trump was wrong, for the bad deal and the bad implementation;
- (vii) Biden was right, for continuation of the Trumpian wish;

I have read all recent negative Fox articles on the infrastructure bill. They are all wrong, to be frank & to be straightforward.

(i) Many issues were mentioned in those articles. But collectively, that accounts for far below 10%. Some are not issues at all, like roadside flower planting. I was actually impressed by the bill for its thoughtfulness.

(ii) Many Republicans, including Trumpian Republicans, are confused 'good' with 'perfect'. The infrastructure bill is by no means perfect, but it is good (actually excellent). Thus, those 19 Republican senators were right, that they voted for a good bill.

(iii) The infrastructure is actually more than good. It is the optimal. In other words, it is the best result under current circumstance. Please bear in mind, it takes only one month to abolish the filibuster and pass slew of rabid socialist bills, including the election law that would kill all Republican White House aspirations in the next 30 years, if the moderate Democrats are fully irritated by Republicans. In other words, many Republicans, especially Trumpian Republicans, must look at the self in a mirror first, then think about if the self is qualified to chase a perfectly beautiful & sexy girl.

The principle of 'Divide & Conquer' is so powerful & so universal, that in mathematics and software engineering, for instance, this principle is employed constantly, for virtually every minute. We always divide a big problem into smaller pieces, then conquer them.

The same is for corona. 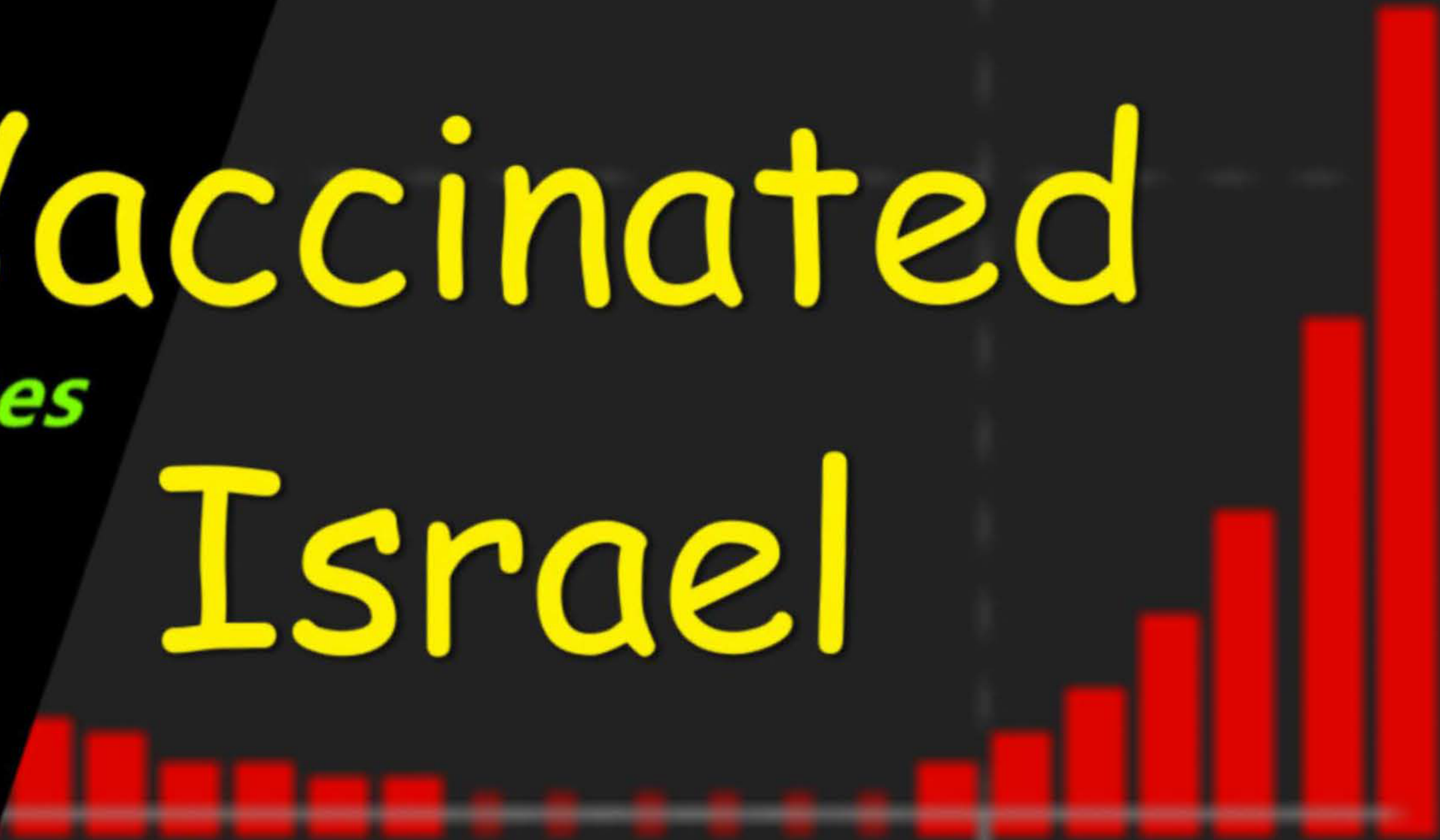

Hi All:

Sandy's mention of the *Youngstown* case reminds me of two points. First, this is a *Youngstown* Category 2 case. Congress has not forbidden the President from acting; it has merely failed to take timely action itself. Second, *Youngstown* is not the latest word from the Supreme Court on presidential emergency powers and private property. That honor goes instead to *Dames & Moore v. Regan*, which upheld a presidential seizure of property to effectuate the release of the 52 Americans held hostage at the Iranian Embassy. Beyond that, there are always the precedents for unilateral presidential assertions of enormous power when Congress is in recess, which were set by Abraham Lincoln in the Civil War between March 4, 1861 and July 4, 1861. I do not agree either as a policy matter or as a matter of constitutional law with what President Biden has done, but there are arguments that could be made to support it.

I agree that the *Debs* dicta are breathtaking in scope. But the presidential assertion of an inherent power to sue for an injunction strikes me as way more modest than a claim to inherent power to impose public health-related restrictions on the use of private property. Thanks for your insights into the legal considerations of an Executive Order for vaccination. I would imagine in congress with parties not as hostile to one another, if state and local entities could not obtain uniform compliance in COVID-19 vaccination, that a bill would be passed to federally mandate the vaccination and, if there wasn't so much social media misinformation and manipulation there would be a more urgent desire for nearly everyone to get vaccinated or at least enough (85%+) as to grind the virus transmission down. Between congressional animosity and the covid-19 pandemic which could potentially go on for years through guaranteed continued mutation it seems we are at the 'you can't get to there from here' stage.

If I were President, based on what I have heard from Professors Shane & Levinson and Calabresi I would first try my luck with Congress to vote on mandating vaccinations from the Federal level nationwide. Hopefully I will be proved wrong and companies and corporations will step up when the FDA soon formally approves the mRNA vaccines and we will be able to reach a vaccination rate of 85-90%. I predict that it will bump us up from 50% to 60-65% which will be far below what is needed to reach herd immunity and will leave us open to future and without exaggeration possibly more deadly variants. A british virology institute stated that a mutation could arise with Delta's transmissibility and a 30% kill rate. Is our Constitution able to accomodate that ? In an emergency even the most vile politician may be forced to change his mind, but how many bodybags, before he comes to that point ?

I believe that the practice of medicine requires knowledge at a level that congress doesn't possess. I believe that medical experts should be given a seat at the table. 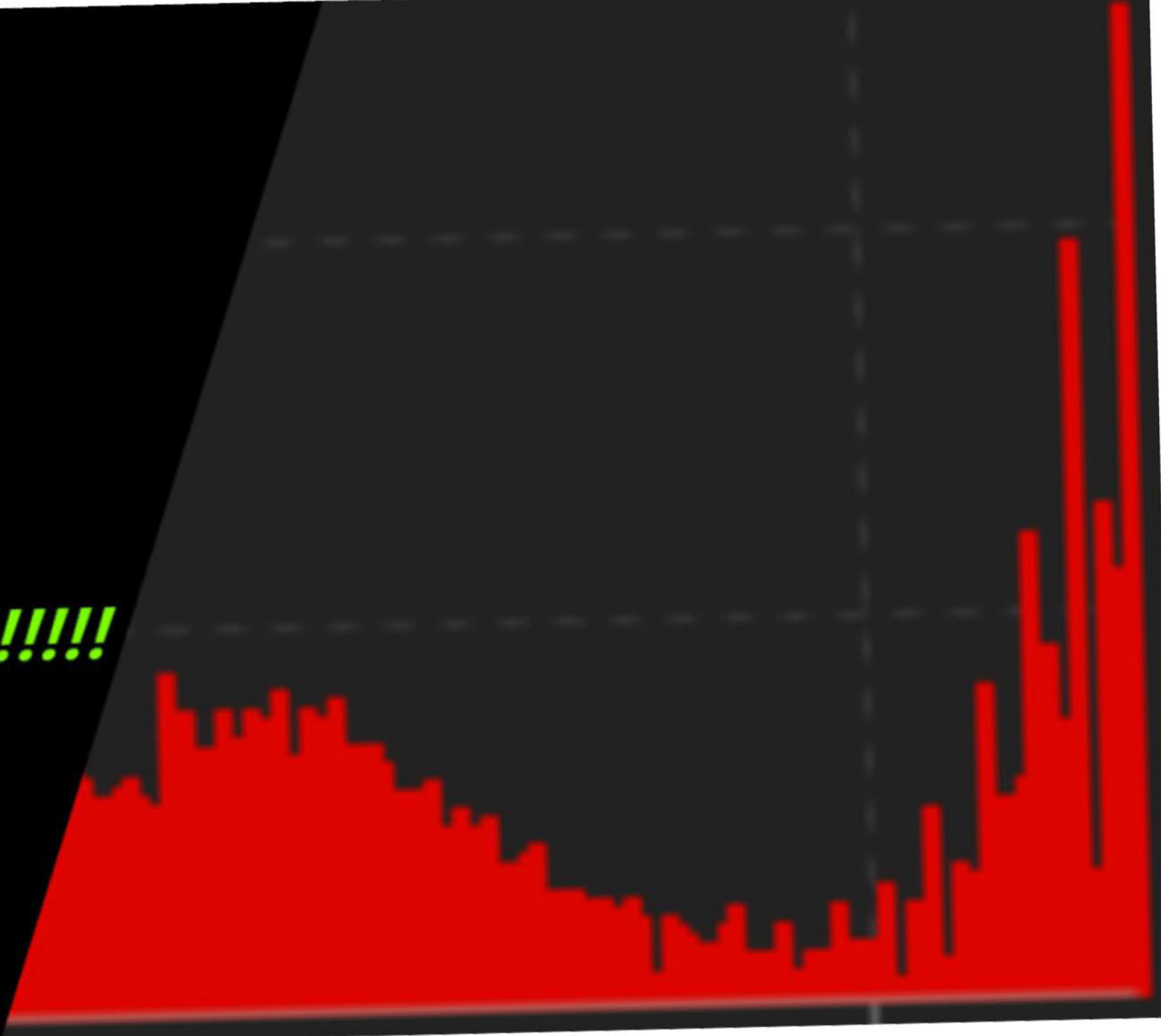

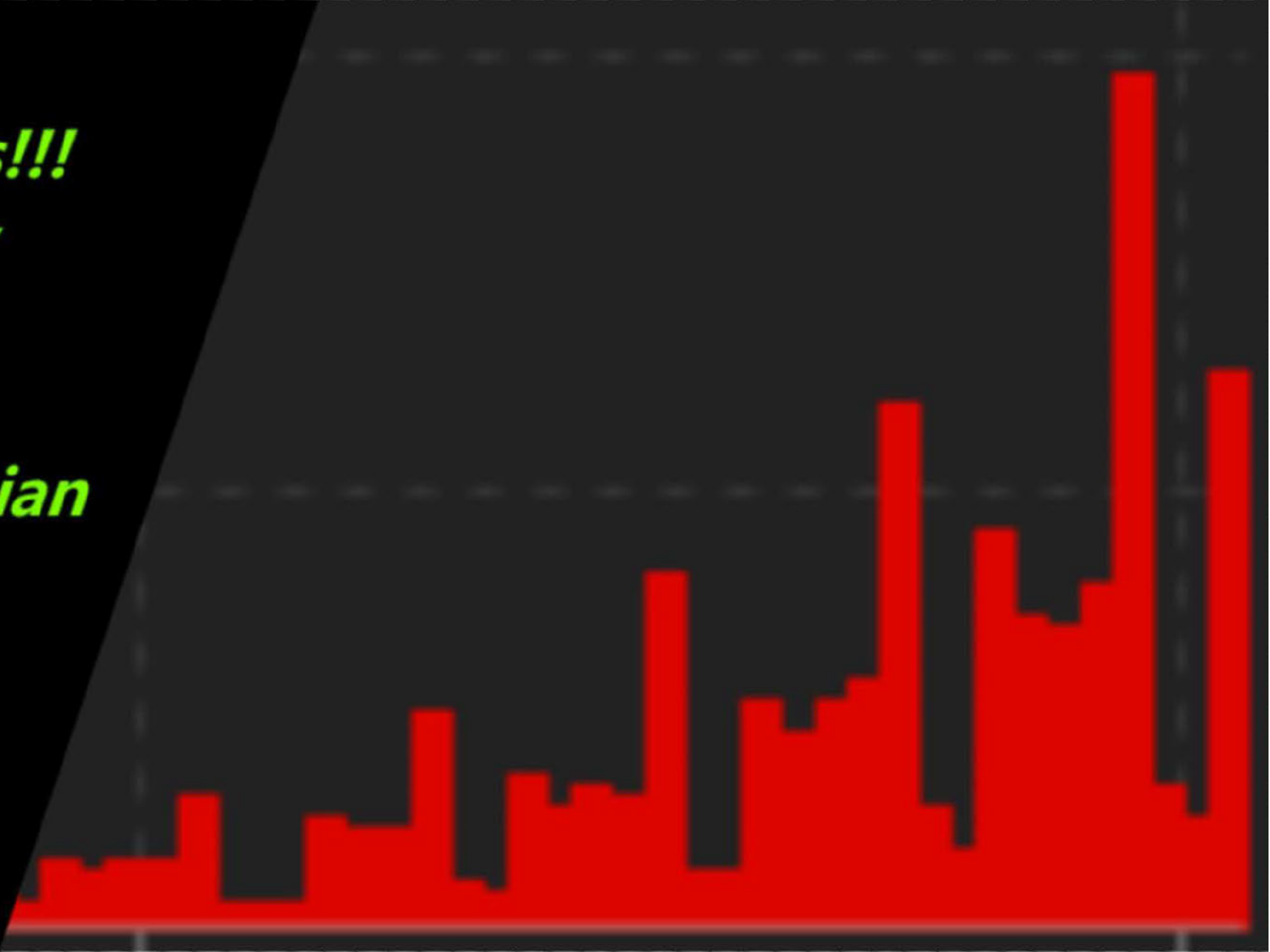

Less than 1% of fully vaccinated people experience a breakthrough Covid-19 infection, analysis finds

Less than 1% of fully vaccinated people experienced a breakthrough infection, according to a Kaiser Family Foundation analysis of official state data.

The federal government only reports data on breakthrough infections that result in hospitalization or death.

According to the latest data from the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, less than 0.004% of people who have been fully vaccinated against Covid-19 experienced a breakthrough case resulting in hospitalization, and less than 0.001% have died from the disease. That's about 6,600 severe breakthrough cases out of more than 163 million fully vaccinated people.

But the KFF analysis shows that breakthrough infections of any kind are also extremely rare.

About half of states report data on Covid-19 breakthrough cases, and in each of those states, less than 1% of fully vaccinated people had a breakthrough infection, ranging from 0.01% in Connecticut to 0.9% in Oklahoma.

Also, more than 90% of cases – and more than 95% of hospitalizations and deaths – have been among unvaccinated people, according to the KFF analysis. In most states, more than 98% of cases were among the unvaccinated.

Thus, without physics the partner, math learning could be boring & ineffective to many people (albeit not to me -- if I can make a living by learning math then I would choose to do so for my entire life).

Based on order of magnitude analysis, 50% is proposed for the maximum income tax ratio and a continuous & smooth function for income tax is proposed

$$y = \begin{cases} 12000 & x \leq 1154156 \\ 50\%x - 1154156 \ln \left(1 + \frac{x}{100000} \right) & x > 1154156 \end{cases}$$

And based on several rules, 15% is proposed for corporate tax ratio. Several other special factors are considered to recheck the reasonability of proposed taxes.

1 Income Tax Function

As analyzed previously, the piecewise constant function of income tax ratio, rampant on this planet, looks rugged & ugly and may be replaced by a unified continuous & smooth cubic polynomial. Unfortunately, it turns out the combination of the high order term and the monetary exponential nature brings in numerical over-sensibility or instability, that a small numerical error during the process of calculation could be amplified to a large error in the final outcome. Thus, the following milder function is proposed instead

$$y = a + bx + c \ln \left(1 + \frac{x}{L} \right) \quad (1)$$

where x stands for income and y stands for tax, L denotes a prescribed characteristic income, to non-dimensionalize x and to improve numerical accuracy, and coefficients a , b , and c can be determined through several means.

2 Order of Magnitude Analysis

Order of magnitude has been introduced before

$$10^0; 10^1; 10^2; 10^3; 10^4; \dots = 1; 3; 10; 30; 100; \dots$$

which suits scenarios where a multiplicative operation is more appropriate. For incomes which display a more exponential distribution, the order of magnitude could be

$$\$18,000; \$30,000; \$100,000; \$1,000,000; \$100,000,000$$

where neighboring incomes increase by increasing order of magnitude, $10^1; 10^2; 10^3; 10^4$. For scenarios with constrained end points such as percentages the order of magnitude could be

$$1\%; 3\%; 10\%; 30\%; 50\%; 70\%; 90\%; 97\%; 99\%$$

where ratios larger than 50% can be regarded as the complements of ratios smaller than 50%. Based on the aforementioned order of magnitude analysis, several quantum points could be proposed for income tax or income tax ratios

† For annual individual income \$0 (uber low-income): -\$12,000

† For annual individual income \$100,000 (middle class): 30%

† For annual individual income \$1 (uber rich): 50%

where the negative tax means a social welfare, the tax ratio 30% also represents for the entire population, and 1 stands for the infinity.

3 Coefficients

The aforementioned three quantum points in Section 2 can be used to determine the three coefficients in tax function (1), where the characteristic income can be set as $L = \$100,000$. After substitution of $x = 0$ into equation (1), the first quantum point reduces the tax function to

$$a = -12000$$

To apply the second and the third quantum points, equation (1) can be rearranged to

$$\frac{y}{x} = \frac{a}{x} + b + \frac{c}{x} \ln \left(1 + \frac{x}{100000} \right)$$

Then the third quantum point at $x = 1$ gives

$$b = 50\%$$

And the second quantum point at $x = 100000$ gives

$$i \frac{12000}{100000} + b + \frac{\ln 2}{100000} c = 30\%$$

After elimination of b through the right above two equations

$$c = i 1154156$$

Finally, a unified continuous & smooth function for the income tax is obtained

$$y = i 12000 + 50\% i 1154156 \ln \left(1 + \frac{x}{100000} \right) \quad (2)$$

Several additional quantum points can be used to check the reasonability of the income tax ratio formula (2)

f At income $x = \$1,000,000$, expression (2) gives tax ratio $y/x = 46\%$, which seems reasonable.

f At income $x = \$30,000$, expression (2) gives tax $y = i \$2809$, which implies Democratic Blacks are going to love it! Because they don't have to pay tax!

Alternatively, the formula (2) can be rewritten as

$$y = i 12000 + 50\% i \frac{1154156}{x} \ln \left(1 + \frac{x}{100000} \right) \quad (3)$$

Thus for Democratic Blacks with income close to \$30,000, formula (3) reduces to

$$y = i 12000 + 40\% x$$

In other words, they pay 40% tax annually, meanwhile get a monthly check of \$1,000.

4 Corporate Tax

What are basic rules to determine the corporate tax? First, the profit should be enticing enough for entrepreneurs and investors. In a typical corporation, human cost accounts for 30% and other operation cost accounts for 30%, thus 10% of corporate tax would be desirable, to leave enticing 30% for profit.

Second, the gross tax of a nation should approximately account for 30% of its GDP. As mentioned previously, 30% is considered as the average income tax ratio for the entire population. Thus, $30\%(\text{human cost ratio}) \pm 30\%(\text{income tax ratio}) + 30\%(\text{profit ratio}) \pm 30\%(\text{income tax ratio}) + 10\%(\text{corporate tax ratio}) = 30\%$. Perfect!

However, historically the corporate tax ratio has been far higher than 10% and an international agreement on the minimum 15% has been reached for international corporations. As a result, 15% of corporate tax is proposed for all corporations in US, domestic or international.

5 Recheck

Indeed, lower tax (income+corporate) then more money for investment, thus expanding economy. However, if the continued low tax results in more debts (or equivalently in ∞ ations), at the end of the day the economy would cease to expand, then shrink. Or from the angle of the Laffer Curve, under the status of too-low tax, the economic increment/gain would be unable to beat the rise of debt, then the prosperity is unsustainable. Here is the US reality:

† According to some theories, if the tax ratio exceeds 50% then a further raise of tax certainly would shrink the economy, but if the tax is below 50% then a tax raise would eventually expand the economy.

† According to some theories, the critical point for sovereign debt is around 2-3 of GDP, beyond which a nation would swirl into an irreversible quantum well and possibly never be able to crawl out. Now after the destructive Trumpian presidency, US sovereign debt has hit a terrifying 4-3 of GDP. At this point of time, what should have been being done is to pray God for the unique status of US currency, immune from the theoretical catastrophe.

† US governmental overspending actually is as severe as thought, in that the nation is not socialized yet. The bigger evil is the decades of rampant personal overspending.

† US physical infrastructure has arrived at a point that a blanket renovation is imperative. And to compete money against socialization, the physical infrastructure must be proceeded ASAP, contrary to the Big Fool's recent comment on the bipartisan \$1.2T. The total would be around \$10 trillions.

† The idea of energy independence turns out to be short sighted, or even silly. US must instead buy foreign resources and push up the international oil price, to 'knock out 5 stones by 1 bird', as discussed before repeatedly. The abolishment of energy independence needs money.

With all these special & vital factors put together, it becomes obvious that, while corporate tax should be remained low to maintain global competitiveness and to expand the economy, the income tax must be greatly ramped up. Like or not, this is the only way to thrive. By the way, even the highly crowed signature feat of Trump's tax cut turned out to be largely wrong.

[Documents show](#) Anthony Fauci's NIH and pharma giant Moderna shared "mRNA Coronavirus Vaccine Candidates" with an expert who [mentored the Wuhan bat lady](#) and "[helped test the COVID vaccine](#)" over a month before COVID-19 was identified.

Originally posted by [Axios](#) last year, documents reveal the U.S. government and Moderna teamed up to send material transfer agreements to top specialists just days before COVID-19 was leaked in Wuhan, China.

The transfer agreement was signed by multiple parties between December 12th and 19th of 2019.

According to the official narrative, the World Health Organization (WHO) became aware of a pneumonia outbreak in the city of Wuhan on December 31, 2019.

Not until January 9, 2020 did [WHO release an official statement](#) regarding the novel coronavirus found in a hospital patient in Wuhan.

One of the signees of the transfer agreement, Dr. Ralph Baric of UNC Chapel Hill, has extremely close ties with the Wuhan Institute of Virology.

In the material transfer form, Fauci and Moderna ask Baric to “perform challenge studies with the mRNA vaccine in a (redacted) model as described on Exhibit A.”

However, “Exhibit A” is also redacted in the document.

Dr. Shi Zhengli, infamously known as the Wuhan “[Bat Woman](#),” was a [lead researcher alongside Baric](#) until she left the UNC-Chapel Hill lab for the Wuhan Institute of Virology.

In fact, Zhengli and Baric published a paper in 2015 describing, “A SARS-like cluster of circulating bat coronaviruses shows potential for human emergence.”

How would they know the cluster specifically associated with the Chinese horseshoe bat shows potential for human emergence?

Well, [in their own words](#), they “built a chimeric by encoding a novel, zoonotic CoV spike protein—from the RsSHC014-CoV sequence that was isolated from Chinese horseshoe bats.”

Next, researchers purposely infected human lungs “for HAE cultures” that “were procured under University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Institutional Review Board–approved protocols.”

While “gain-of-function” research [was banned in America in 2014](#), the 2015 Baric/Zhengli paper admits, “Continuation of these studies was requested, and this has been approved by the NIH.”

Interestingly, a note at the end of the research paper explains the authors originally omitted the fact that EcoHealth Alliance (EHA) funded their work.

EHA is the same group Fauci’s NIH used to funnel money to the Wuhan Institute of Virology where Baric’s co-worker Dr. Shi Zhengli is the lab director.

EHA’s president, Peter Daszak, was also the only American sent to Wuhan to “investigate” the lab leak theory, which he unsurprisingly dismissed.

In fact, as lead investigator for the WHO investigation, Daszak [determined within 3 hours of](#)

[visiting the Wuhan lab](#) in February 2021 that there was “nothing to see here.”

With Daszak’s obvious conflict of interest regarding the Wuhan lab and gain-of-function research now making headlines, he was just [recused from his position](#) as head investigator looking into COVID origins for the medical journal *The Lancet*.

After Dr. Ralph Baric experimented with gain-of-function research, he created the coronavirus treatment drug [Remdesivir for pharma giant Gilead](#), a company that has received over \$6.5 billion from Fauci’s NIH in the past few years.

Now, [Baric has teamed up with scientists](#) to create another money-maker in what they call a “universal vaccine” that targets coronaviruses.

“The vaccine has the potential to prevent outbreaks when used as a new variant is detected,” said Baric.

“With this strategy, perhaps we can prevent a SARS-CoV-3,” a co-creator of the universal vaccine ominously stated.

In 2018, Baric spoke at a conference on the 100-year anniversary of the 1918 Spanish Flu Pandemic and explained one day somebody could sell vaccines to people who want to vaccinate themselves at home.

“Most likely, somebody will come up with a way to sell that in a legal way, not a safe way,” he said.

Could the “universal” coronavirus vaccine he just helped create be marketed for at-home use?

Baric even detailed how one could hypothetically “make money in the next pandemic,” providing a “global catastrophe opportunities” chart.

Another entity that would like to keep the origins of COVID-19 a secret is the Chinese military, [which was on the record conducting secret research](#) at the Wuhan Institute of Virology.

[A new report by the Washington Post](#), an outlet that previously denied the lab leak theory, [acknowledges](#) classified military research was carried out at the lab and that records will almost certainly remain sealed by the Chinese government for two decades.

“The secrecy may help to explain why efforts to confirm or disprove the lab-leak theory of the pandemic’s origins have made little progress,” the report admits.



1 A Brilliant Design

How to make a good policy?

† Phase I: Be bold, imaginative, and inclusive, to put everything on the table. This is an induction/expansion process. House was designed to serve this purpose.

† Phase II: Be prudent, logical, and selective, to narrow down the optimal policy. This is a deduction/condensation process. Senate was designed to serve this purpose.

The expansion-condensation pair is quite ubiquitous in the universe. In the filibuster case, the numerator isn't a whole number, and the '+' is missing in the exclusive/exclusive treatment of the boundary. To make the rule simpler & smoother, the filibuster could be renormalized as:

† Filibuster: $7/12+$ (59 votes to get a bill passed)

Table 1: Persuadablesenators could be narrowed down through 6 factors, color of the state, contentiousness in recent election, time correlation, political prospect, political views, and character & logic. The table was created mainly in March 2021 thus some information might have been outdated and the analysis might be premature.

3 Persuadable Senators

An analysis on persuadable Democratic senators is arranged in Table 1, where 'carrot' means praises and sometimes offers.

4 Carrot & Stick

It takes only three months to abolish the filibuster and pass a slew of rabid radical Democratic destructive bills, and per status in quo, Party Lincoln is all but certain to lose several senatorial seats, possibly 6 net seats, in the 2022 midterm, in that Trump, the biggest RHINO hiding within Party Elephants, has been fighting like hell to gut the party. must fight like hell to press on persuadable Democratic senators, so that even after 2022 the filibuster still could be possibly preserved. Some exemplary cases are as follows:

- † Senator Joe Manchin: Bring a carrot only, and continue to praise him and convince him, such as about the lowering of the threshold as shown in Figure 2 (a).
- † Senator Jon Tester: Bring both carrot & stick, and press on very hard, for a stance. Remind the senator of the redness of the state. Of course don't forget to bring with convincing arguments.
- † Senator Mark Kelly: Bring both carrot & stick, and press on very hard. Before, the senator promised to vote by logic; after, he voted by tribe. Promise made, promise broken.
- † Senator Sherrod Brown: Bring a stick, and press on very hard, for a stance. Remind the senator that Ohio is red.
- † Senator Raphael Warnock: Bring a stick, and press on very hard. As in Arizona, in purple states an adverse stance on filibuster or a dodge may not hurt, but pressing on is still very good, and saves way more money than an ad blitz.
- † Senator Angus King: Bring a carrot, since the senator expressed the reluctance (Figure 2 (b)).

† Senator Dianne Feinstein: Bring a carrot. The senator will retire at the end of the term, thus could vote by logic.

5 Pathlines

How to pressure? In non-campaign mode, pathlines include:

† Lobbying: The most efficient approach is to lobby, i.e., to directly talk to persuadable senators. But good arguments must be well prepared in advance. This approach costs zero money.

† Democratic Media: The second most important approach is to foray into Democratic media to directly talk to 80,000,000 swing voters. This approach costs zero money and can produce a few byproducts. Party Lincoln may dispatch so-called RHINOS to fulfill the task, since they are more welcomed there.

† Protest: After the Capitol riot misled by Trump, Republicans may be scared by the idea of protesting. However, peaceful street protest is still fine, and useful to pressure individuals. And this approach could possibly make a big piece of news and draw wide attention, and it costs zero money.

† Emails/mails: Emails/mails ain't effective, but due to extremely low cost the efficiency of this approach isn't low.

There are several other approaches, but they cost money and suit better in campaign mode.

6 Summary

Party Lincoln has been working very hard, but far from hard enough yet. A lot of basic work hasn't been done yet. Make no mistake about it, that as long as Trump stays in the way, the Party is all but certain to lose 2022, and 2024. Thus, Party Lincoln must fight like hell.

That's everything the country produces in a year. Investors worry about default when the debt-to-GDP ratio is greater than 77%. That's the tipping point, according to a study by the World Bank. It found that if the debt-to-GDP ratio exceeds 77% for an extended period of time, it slows economic growth. Every percentage point of debt above this level costs the country 0.017 percentage points in annual economic growth.^[6]



Note: The tipping point for emerging market countries is 64%. If the debt-to-GDP ratio is higher, it will slow growth by 0.02 percentage points each year.^[6]

At some point, the country can't afford to keep rolling over debt. When it threatens to default, it creates a crisis. That's what caused the Greek debt crisis, leading to the eurozone debt crisis.^[9] Iceland defaulted when it bailed out its banks.^[10]

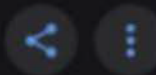

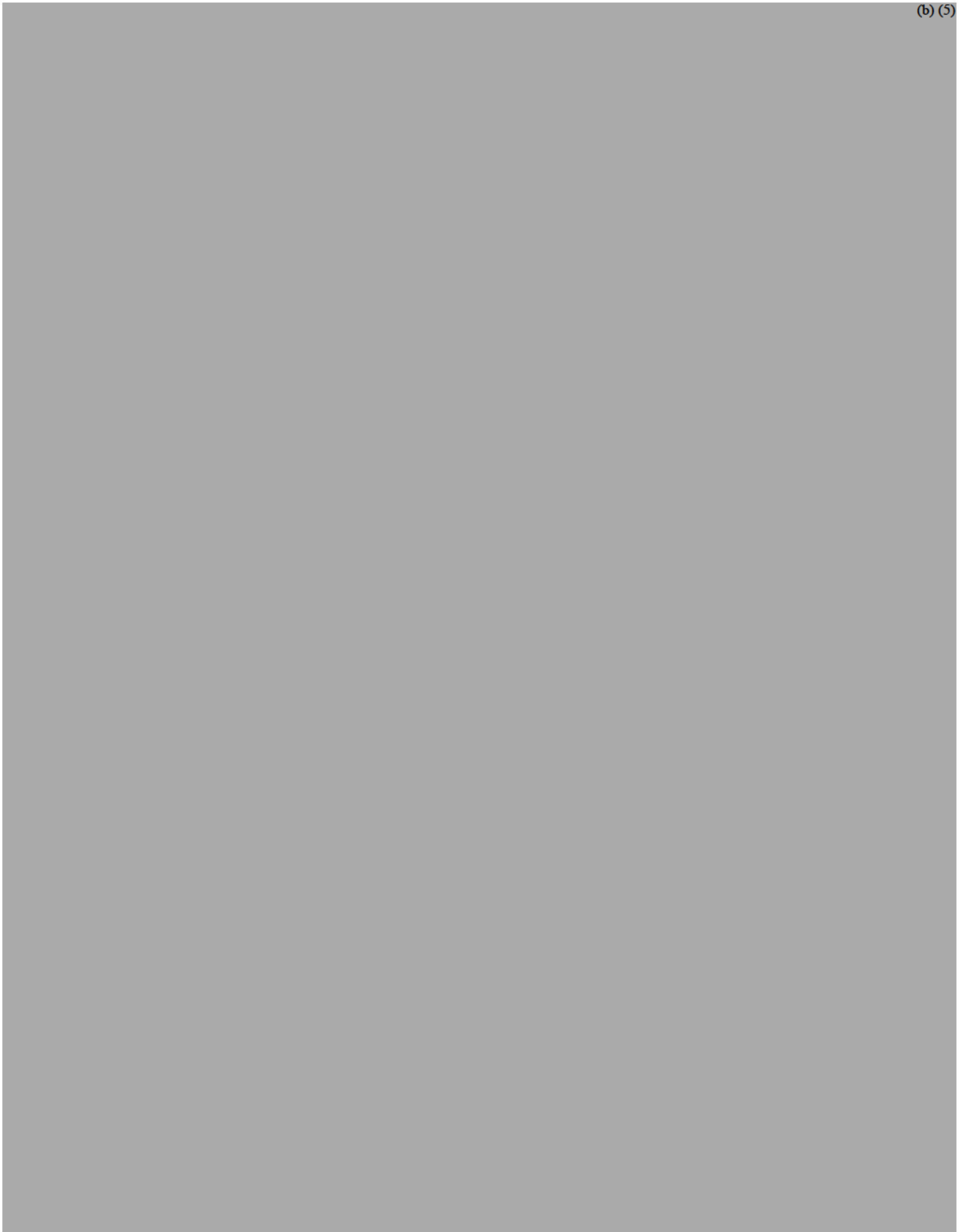

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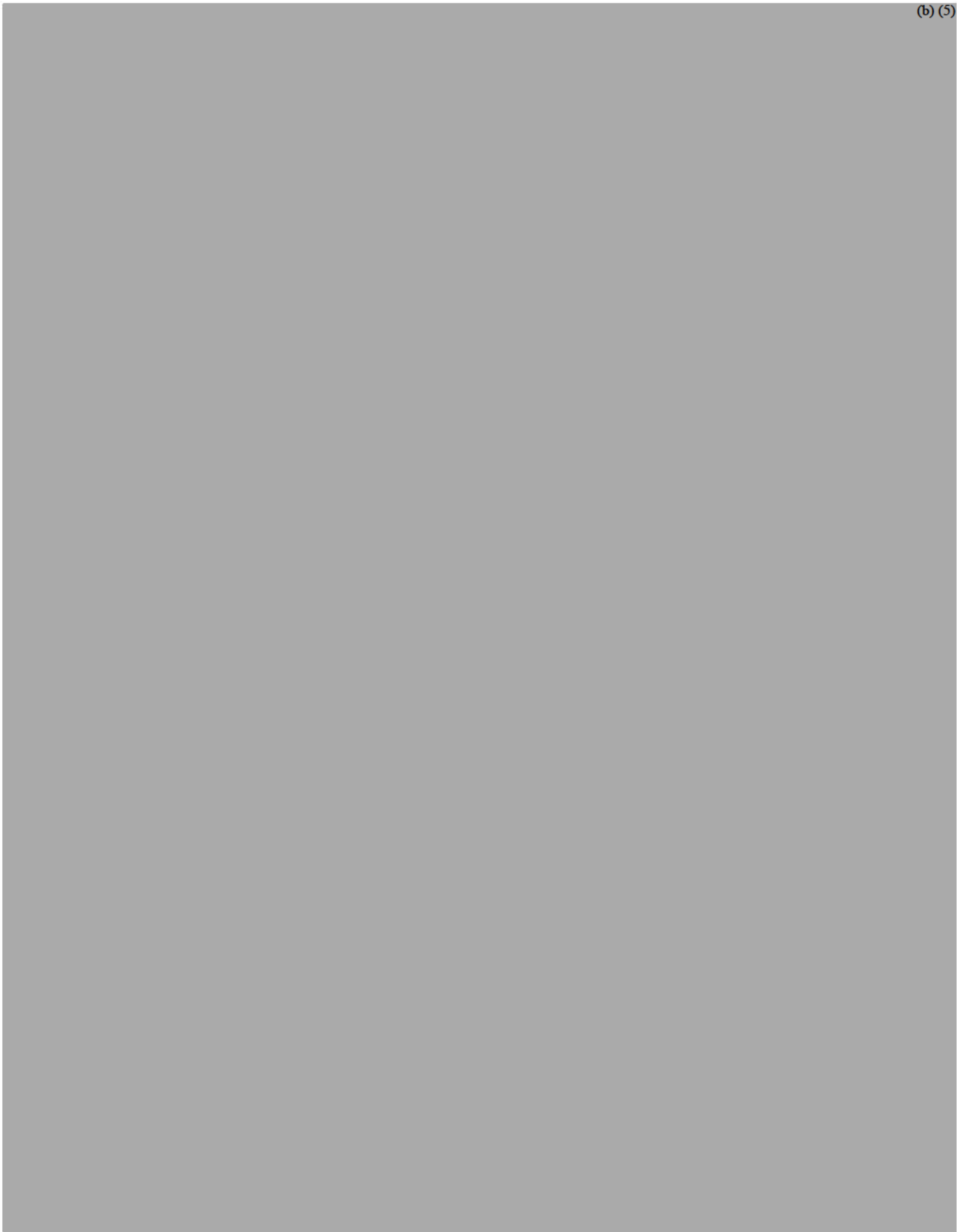
