



Hi team, congratulations on your publication!

My only comment, as the one plant health specialist to weigh in on the paper, is that the term 'Plant biology' in the gaps section is uninformative and non sequitur. The entire discussion piece deals with health. Health of humans, health of animals, food safety for human health, etc. I suggested that you use 'Plant Health', which is the terminology that my colleagues would identify with and the most relevant to the One Health topic area. In the plant health disciplines there are many important interfaces with one health, including: global surveillance, validation of diagnostic assays, epidemiological risk assessments, advanced genomic and

transcriptomic diagnostic methods, and detection technologies. Plant health practitioners use biological and chemical treatments that are measured by dose response and LD50, and are concerned with AMR in crops treated with antibiotics for control of bacterial disease.

## Concept for "The Impact of Plant Health on Human Health and Food Security and Safety: A One Health Perspective"

Plant health is critical for ensuring sufficient, safe, and nutritious food—which is necessary to fostering healthy populations and productive societies. Plants constitute over 80% of the food that people eat and are key to the sustainable development of agriculture responsible for nourishing the continuously growing global population. However, while plant diseases and pests have continued to directly and indirectly influence human health, they have been under-recognized as an integral contributor to human health outcomes. As the world faces increasing challenges to food security and safety from climate change and other global threats, plant-associated issues are likely to continue unabated and potentially be exacerbated, unless effective management tactics are introduced and widely adopted.

With the upcoming United Nations Year of Plant Health in 2020, this analytic essay—through three case studies—illuminates the variety of mechanisms, interactions, and consequences in which plantrelated pathogens threaten human health through food plants. The cases also examine challenges and opportunities for mitigating adverse health outcomes emerging from these complex interrelationships. Specifically, the first case study explores the pathways and effects of contamination of staple crops such as maize with aflatoxin, produced by a common environmental fungus; this contamination could potentially cause acute liver disease and other chronic illnesses, as exemplified by the 2004 outbreak of aflatoxicosis in Kenya. The second case study explores how Shiga toxin-producing *E.coli* can contaminate produce through animal feces and other mechanisms, causing severe illnesses such as kidney failure, as recently experienced in the E.coli outbreak of romaine lettuce in the United States and Canada in 2018-2019. The final case study examines the use of pesticides in plant agriculture and their contributions to antimicrobial resistance as well as affecting birth outcomes and other health issues if misused and unregulated, as shown in the case of Suriname. Drawing from the three case studies, the authors conclude with recommendations for mitigating health and societal consequences arising from these complex interrelationships and emphasize the importance of applying a multidisciplinary and multisectoral One Health approach to enhance public health.






## MEMBERSHIP BREAKDOWN: By Location, Expertise, Sector, and Gender




**Low representation**: International and Midwest




