Dear Jonna and Peter,

We met a few times over the past years when I worked as head of Global for Smithsonian, alongside Suzan (copied here). I'm writing today to see if we could pick up a new conversation. A year ago I left the Smithsonian and moved to Copenhagen to lead a new global organization – called UN Live – whose mission is to inspire billions of people to begin to take personal action towards the SDGs. We are officially branded and endorsed by the UN, but were intentionally designed to sit outside the UN, so that we could be more progressive and riskier in our programs and strategies. The core of our work is currently focused on climate and biodiversity. Long before this pandemic, I had been in touch with partners we share – such as Wellcome, etc – to begin to design a program that helps people understand how intimately our lives are connected to the health of the planet, and to functioning ecosystems.
