- *LNSP is wrapping up a massive laboratory capacity project in which solar powered generators with battery-powered back up are being installed, along with equipment and ensured security. At this moment, We have two person only access to the room key and Freezer key. Mr. Mamun is daily record the temperature. Mr. Mamun is responsible for archiving the samples and maintain sample submission from freezer to IEDCR lab and ICDDR, b animal lab for sample testing.

- Is the freezer housed in a locked room? Who has access to that room?

Ans: Yes, the freezer is housed in a dedicated lock room. PREDICT country coordinator and PREDICT program associate, Mr. Mamun has access to the freezer room. The freezer room and laboratory is in different physical location. The lab personnel collect the working priority samples from freezer after communicate with Mr. Mamun to get access.

Ans: Yes, laboratory and freezer room is within secure place. It has 24 hrs security guard facility. Only appropriated person can enter the lab and the freezer room those have finger print access.
