All:

Spoke to ATSDR- good conversation, spoke to the branch chief. They are “holding their tox profile in limbo” until EPA’s PRA comes out. They “don’t want to say something completely different than [EPA]” and art trying to harmonize their conclusions. They agreed to a meeting or conference call. Will work with Jen to create an agenda and then send to them

Spoke to EPA- Spoke with the Assistant Director of the Health Effects Division and Chair of the EPA Cancer Committee (CARC): they need nothing from us now, he continues to say that “glyphosate does not cause cancer” and shares our view that IARC had an agenda and was wrong. I have shared with him the links to various other regulator statements that Jen provided. The CARC will review the IARC monograph and finalize its view in September, this means the PRA will not come out until September at the earliest.
