Douglas,

In trying to finish up the manuscript, we currently have the following situation/activities ongoing:

- 1) experts reviewing the 5/20/99 CanTox manuscript
- 2) at least G. Williams has sent in comments (and presumably have been entered into the CanTox manuscript)
- 2) WFH reviewing the genetox section of the 5/20/99 CanTox manuscript
- 3) DRF reconstructing all the references into 1 list with proper citations
- 4) Monsanto QA audited the 5/7/99 Monsanto Manuscript
- 5) Monsanto QA later audited the 5/20/99 CanTox manuscript GENETOX section ONLY + new Tables
- 6) SJW has finished all responses to QA audit (entered into 5/7/99 Monsanto manuscript)

I won't even begin to go into how we got to this point. But we are here. As a result of trying to have many people do many things in different places at the same time, we currently have 2 "orignal" manuscripts:

- 1) The Monsanto Manuscript for the Exposure Section and Tables
- 2) The Cantox Manuscript for everything else + Tables

Since there are extensive QA audits awaiting responses for both manuscripts, and QA will need to again audit the entire manuscript after everything is put together before it goes to the journal (top Monsanto Management decision - non-negotiable), we have concluded it is best if Monsanto assumes 'ownership' of all pieces and puts them together into 1 complete "original". This will facilitate resolution of all issues with Monsanto's QA unit.

Douglas, toward this end, please send me the experts comments shown in revision mode. I will incorporate them into the "Original".

The question, then, is what to use as the "original" - the Cantox format or the Monsanto format. Douglas did you format the CanTox manuscript into the format requested by Food & Chemical Tox.? Or do I need to find out what that is and reformat the "original" document?
