





Lead Author's Comments: (Please provide information on purpose of presentation/publication and any relevant patents or manuscript disclosures.) The primary purpose of this manuscript is to prepare for a possible glyphosate carcinogenicity evaluation by the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC). IARC reviews do not consider unpublished data in their carcinogenicity evaluations. To bring the substantial glyphosate mammalian carcinogenicity data base to bear in an IARC weight of evidence evaluation, it is necessary to publish on the Glyphosate Task Force member company studies. In addition, IARC review committees are unfortunately selected based on expertise on the subject matter, as reflected their publication record. This paper is the third such manuscript on relevant glyphosate studies (first epidemiology, then genotoxicity) which brings balance to both the published subject matter and the pool of eligible expert authors for possible election to an IARC glyphosate carcinogenicity review committee. In addition, this review further casts doubt on the quality and integrity of the Seralini et al. (2012) rat study, in light of both industry data and published academic research.
