Attached is the first draft of a manuscript that I prepared with the intention of submitting either as a co-author with some global faculty in animal sciences or turn it over to them and just be a ghost writer. The paper is not Nobel Prize science but it is intended to provide two simple messages: 1) billions of animals are consuming large amounts of GM crops everyday for long periods and, 2) the forecasted health effects are not apparent in publicly available datasets. Before I send it to them I would appreciate your feedback on content.

I also would like to hear your thought as well on authorship. I do not need to be on it and think that a non-MON paper is the best-case scenario. I am concerned that the faculty members may not want to just take something they did not produce and slap their names on it. I have talked to two EU scientists and two from the US (one is a Department Chair) that are willing to entertain the idea but we have not gotten into the details yet.
